Corpus Christi Processions: Sunday, June 6, 2021:

- As parishes begin to plan for summer events, including Corpus Christi processions, we would like to share a reminder that **all social gatherings and meetings should adhere to the guidelines and mandates set forth by the county in which the parish resides.**
- For parishes planning a procession, it will be best if people line the procession route and are properly spaced/distanced, rather than walk the route with the minister and servers. We recommend that only the minister and two or three servers are part of the procession. This allows for participation from the faithful while adhering to local mandates. We will share any additional relevant updates prior to June 6. Important Announcement:

In the afternoon on Friday, May 14, 2021, the Office of the Archdiocese of made this important announcement: The mask mandate now only applies to **all parish faithful who have not received a vaccination against the COVID-19 virus.** Following the CDC guidance issued yesterday, capacity restrictions and social-distancing measures at archdiocesan parishes will be determined by the parish pastor based on the size and construct of the parish, and what he deems is needed to provide for the safest possible environment. These changes in guidance are effective immediately; however, the timeline for implementation in each parish will be determined by the pastor based on specific needs to make a safe and appropriate transition. Changes should be implemented at all parishes no later than Sunday, May 23.

Archbishop Mitchell Rozanski leaves in place the dispensation for Sunday Mass at this time, but will be re-evaluating the need for the dispensation in the coming weeks.

We are sorry to inform you of the passing of Jean Rozanski, mother of Archbishop Mitchell T. Rozanski. Mrs. Rozanski passed away Wednesday, May 19th in Baltimore, Maryland. She was 84 years old. Archbishop Rozanski was able to return to Baltimore before his mother's passing. A devoted wife and mother, Jean is preceded in death by her husband Alfred Rozanski, who passed away in December 2020. They were married for 64 years. Alfred and Jean instilled in Archbishop Rozanski and his brothers a strong devotion to the Lord and His Church here on earth.

Jean Rozanski is survived by her sons, Archbishop Mitchell Rozanski, Kenneth (Lisa) and Albert (Danielle), four grandchildren, and one great-grandchild.
