**Today's Gospel: Lk 19: 1-10** At that time, Jesus came to Jericho and intended to pass through the town. So he ran ahead and climbed a sycamore tree in order to see Jesus, who was about to pass that way. When they all saw this, they began to grumble, saying, "He has gone to stay at the house of a sinner."
