**Today's Gospel: Mt 17: 1-9** Jesus took Peter, James, and John his brother, and led them up a high mountain by themselves. #### Holy Father's Intention for March: For victims of abuse

We pray for those who have suffered harm from members of the Church; may they find within the Church herself a concrete response to their pain and suffering.

#### Ash Wednesday (Feb 22, 2023), all Fridays of Lent and Good Friday (April 7, 2023):

are days of abstinence (refraining from meat) for all Catholics from age 14 onwards. On these two days, fast, as well as abstinence, is also obligatory for those from the ages of 18-59. Abstinence means refraining from meat. Fast means one full meal a day, with two smaller meals and nothing between meals (liquids are permitted). No Catholic will lightly excuse himself or herself from this obligation.

**Rice Bowl:** CRS Rice Bowl begins on Ash Wednesday, Feb 22, 2023, 75 percent of Rice Bowl donations support CRS's humanitarian relief programs in more than 100 different countries. Additionally, Catholic Relief Services allows each diocese that participates to keep 25% of the collection in the local community to be used for hunger and poverty alleviation efforts. In the Archdiocese of St. Louis, these funds support food pantries and other programs.
